

Ripon High School Hall of Fame

Ripon High School is excited to announce that the application process for the Hall of Fame Class is now available. Please be sure to review this entire document, "Policies and Procedures" (P/P) before beginning the process.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- An individual may be nominated in one of three categories. They are: athlete, coach, or other. The definitions of each category may be found under Article VI.
- An individual may be nominated by anyone. The application process must be completely filled out and the packet of information submitted in full. The requirements for the nomination packet can be found in Section VI of the P/P. Note: Please include the most relevant materials to validate the nominee's accomplishments and do not duplicate any supporting documentation.

- The application process closes on May 20, 2010.

CRITERIA

- The criteria is listed in the P/P under Article VI.

SELECTION PROCESS

- There will be a two-step selection committee that is outlined in the P/P, Articles IV and V.
- The 1st class will include no more than 25 selections. Each successive year will be limited to no more than five inductees.
- It is the plan of the Ripon High School Hall of Fame to announce the inductees of the 1st Class in to the Ripon High School Hall of Fame in August, 2010.

TIMELINES

- Please review the document on Page 6, titled, "Timelines for Implementation".
- Each inductee will be asked to visit Ripon High School on a set date for a short video interview (if possible) that will be used during the ceremony. The date of the interview will be established after the Class of 2010 is announced.
- The date for the actual ceremony has not been set yet.
